



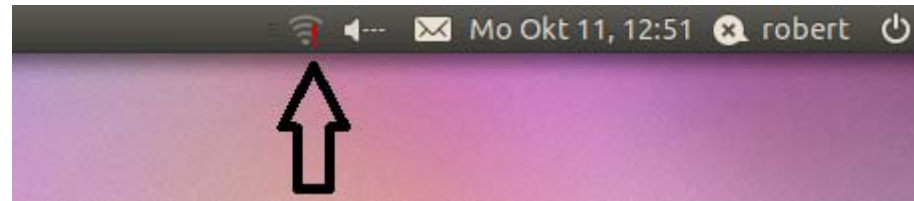
VPN with Ubuntu 10.10 (10.04 analog)

Prerequisites

- Ubuntu 10.04 oder 10.10 – early versions have no built-in vpn-client
- All settings must(!) exactly be set as described
- No modifications shall be done to Ubuntu or Gnome

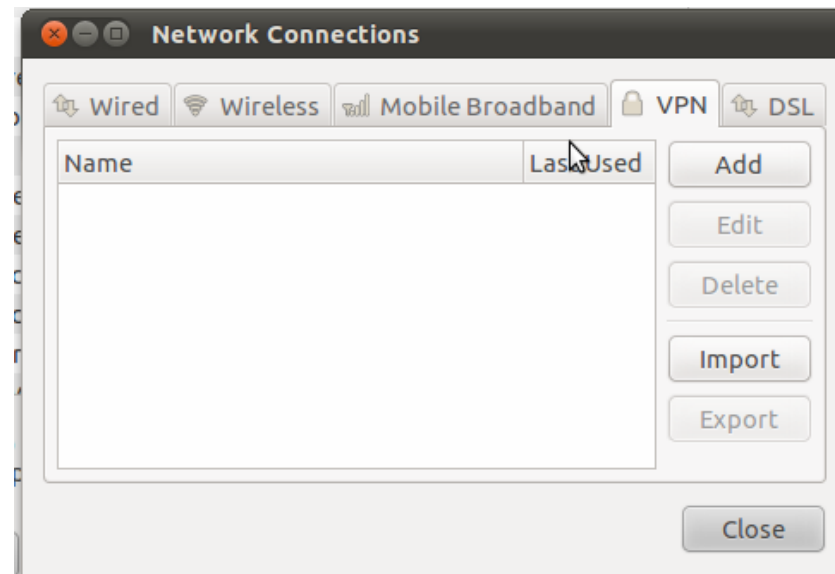
1. Step

- Click on the network interface icon in the upper right



2. Step

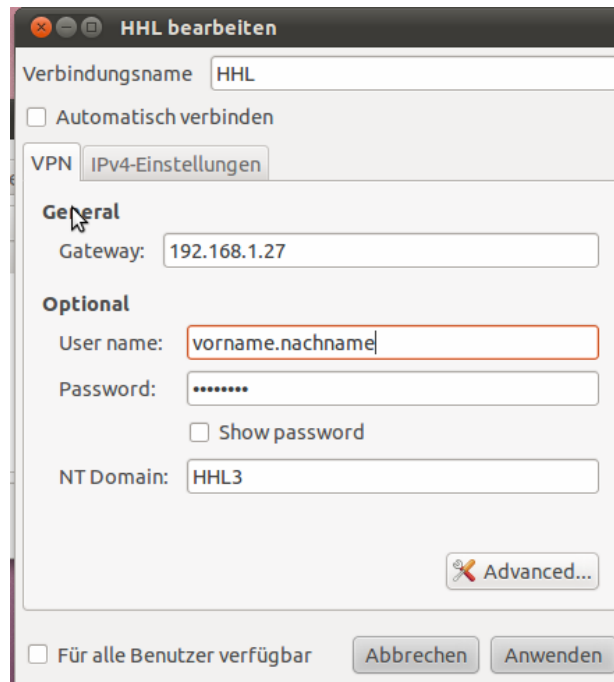
- Chose : VPN-Connection -> configure VPN
- You should see this windows:



- Click on „add“

3. Step

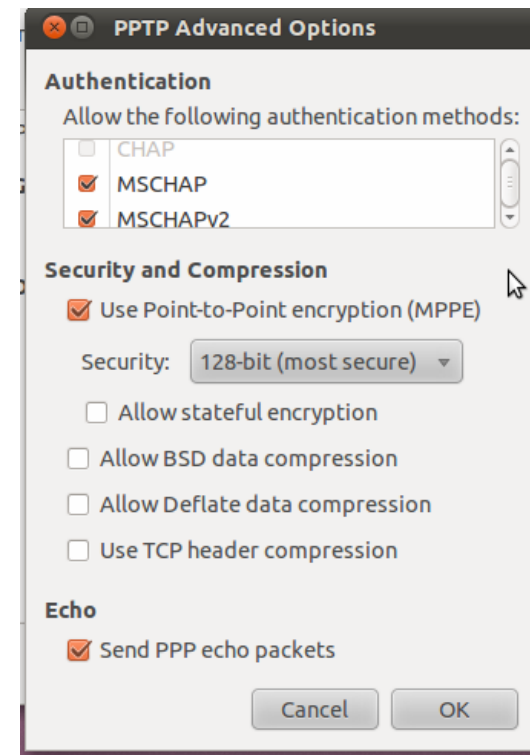
- Copy these settings (except `vorname.nachname` – this should be your login information!:



- Click on „advanced“

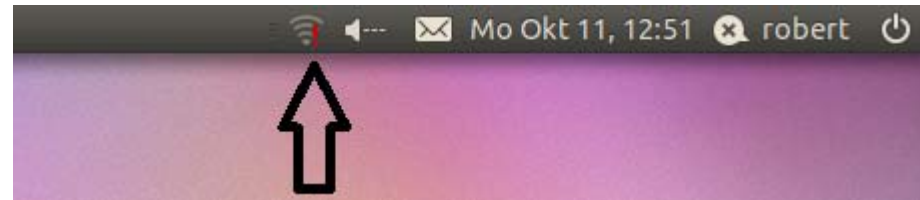
4. Step

- deselect all elements from the list except MSCHAP und MSCHAP v2
- Select MPPE → 128Bit
- Deselect everything else, select Echo:
- OK



5. Step

- Save everything
- Close all windows
- Click on the network interface:
- Select VPN
- Select your VPN
