GdF was originally founded in 1922 in order to support the Handelshochschule during the difficult time of the economic crisis after the first world war. After 27 years, GdF was liquidated by the authorities in 1949 due to political changes. After Germany's re-unification GdF was revived in 1991 and played an important role in the context of the re-foundation of HHL. Its sole aim remained to promote and support teaching, research and academic development at HHL. In practice this means regular financial support but also an annual award for the top student of each class, the research award for young scientists, and contributions to scholarships by *Beta Gamma Sigma* and DAAD, for instance.

As membership fees are the main source of this allowances every new member increases the capability of GdF. You are very welcome to join us, either in person or representing your company.
