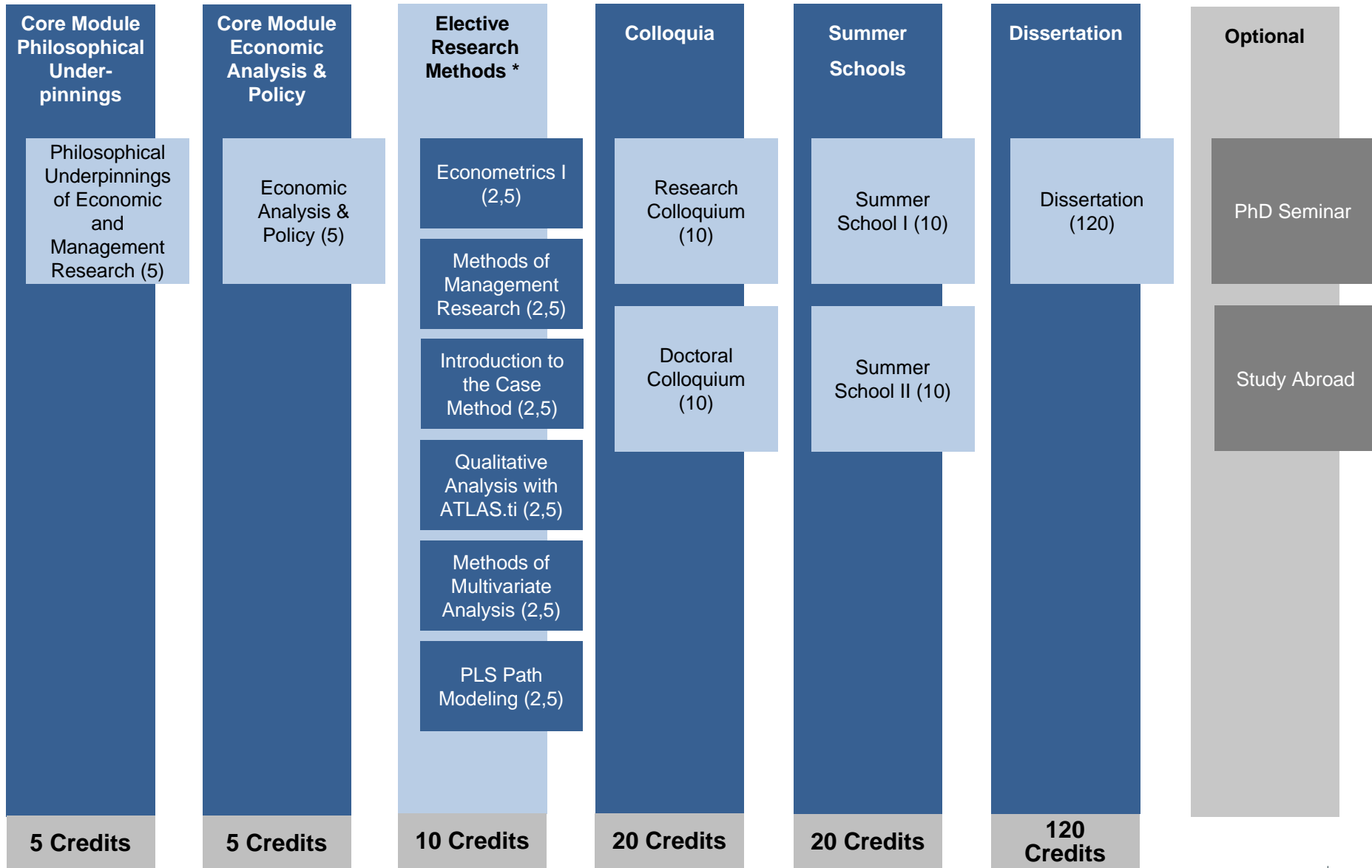


The Doctoral Program consists of six mandatory parts - optional parts can be taken on a voluntary basis
