Admission criteria

Euro*MBA participants are open minded, dynamic, eager to learn and contribute to the community and have a professional background. Most Euro*MBA students have on average 11 years of professional working experience. Each candidate is evaluated individually by the Programme Director and the Academic Council on his/her professional achievements, academic excellence, commitment to learning, and communication skills.

Basic Admission Criteria

- 5 years of professional working experience
- Bachelors degree
- Proficiency in English
 - work experience in an English speaking environment,
 - education in an English speaking institute, or
 - a minimum score of 250 at the computer based TOEFL test (100 for internet based)*

* Other language tests may be acceptable. Please contact the helpdesk for information.

Remarks

- Diplomas from non European countries will be submitted for evaluation to Nuffic, Dutch Institute for Diploma Comparison of the Ministry of Education.
- All applications are reviewed by the Euro*MBA Academic Council. The Academic Council reserves the right to accept or reject applications.

Fees

Euro*MBA programme fees are €28.500** for the two year programme, billed in two instalments over the course of the programme. The programme fees cover academic costs, all tutoring, organised components of the residential weeks, course materials and Lotus Notes programme and license. The programme fee does not cover travel, catering and accommodation costs of the residential weeks (estimated €800-€900 per week).

** Applicants are expected to cover banking and/or wire transfer costs. Payment in 6 instalments is also possible (with additional administrative costs).
