About the Rising Stars ranking

The new ranking Rising Stars by Findyourmba.com is based on the business schools' improvements in the past four years and data of the year 2007 and 2008. Some data which is used by established rankings is also used for the Rising Stars. On the other hand, many variables, which are ignored by the established rankings, such as forum and internet activities among MBA students, politics, long term investments of business schools, and strategic choices, are included in the Rising Stars survey. Other variables take e.g. from extensive alumni questionnaires which are used by the established rankings are not included in the methodology by Findyourmba.com. About the programme

"The Euro★MBA is a two year international executive program offered by a Consortium of six top European business schools and universities: Maastricht University (the Netherlands), Audencia Nantes (France), EADA Barcelona (Spain), HHL Leipzig (Germany), IAE Aix-en-Provence (France) and Kozminski University Warsaw (Poland). The Euro★MBA has three international accreditations.

Distance learning is an upcoming phenomenon within the field of MBA. Findyourmba.com does not differentiate within the Rising Stars Ranking on the method of education. Euro★MBA is a program with a significantly diverse international student population. Further, 30% of the students are female and the average age is around 36.

The Euro★MBA fits the needs of the current executive to combine theoretical and practical training and work, allowing them to study from home, yet to work with executives from around the world. Since its inception in 1996, flexibility, high quality theoretical and practical training, innovative work processes and international network have been the keywords of the Euro★MBA program.

The program consists of a master thesis, ten core distance learning business modules, residential weeks and an introduction seminar. The program is AMBA, AACSB and EQUIS accredited by several schools. **It is at the moment one of the best programs to**

combine studying in an international environment with a busy work life. The program is rising at the moment and has potential to become the best distance learning program in the world".

Official MBA Guide Announces New MBA Scholarship Policy

Each year the Official MBA Guide awards a \$1,000 scholarship to a student who enrolls in an MBA program offered by a university listed in the Official MBA Guide data base. The scholarship recipient is selected from all prospective MBA students who satisfy the criteria described below.

The Official MBA Guide is a free public service designed to help students find the MBA program that best suits their preferences and criteria. Since 1997, the Official MBA Guide has listed more than 2,000 MBA programs worldwide. Visitors can limit their search to full-time, part-time, executive, distance-learning, and accelerated MBA programs. They can search in specific geographic regions, for specific field concentrations, and can specify a variety of criteria and preferences to obtain a list of MBA programs that best fit their needs. They can examine official data about each MBA program, as provided by university administrators, link to the universities' web sites, and contact the universities by email.

The Official MBA Guide data base contains more than 1,000 universities, most of which take advantage of the free service at no charge. Some MBA programs pay a small annual fee to obtain special student recruiting services. The Official MBA Guide is available to any MBA program that wishes to be listed. Virtually all AACSB accredited programs are included.

To qualify for the annual scholarship, visitors must register with the Official MBA Guide at <http://officialmbaguide.org> and complete the demographic, academic, and work experience portions of the registration form. Personally-identifiable information provided to the Official MBA Guide is kept strictly confidential and is not disclosed to anyone. Scholarship winners must be enrolled or accepted into an MBA program within a year of selection. The scholarship is paid directly to the school on behalf of the recipient.

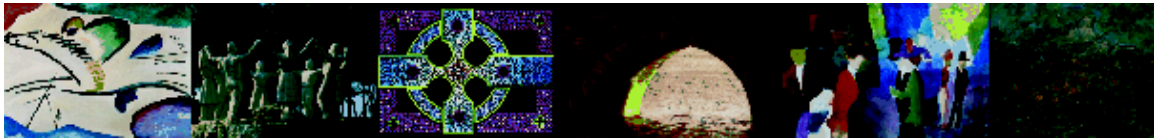
