

HHL Part-time M.Sc. Entry Test

The HHL Part-time M.Sc. Entry Test is a standardized, three-part exam delivered in English. The test is designed to help the Admissions Committee evaluate how suitable individual applicants are for HHL's part-time M.Sc. Program. Therefore, it measures basic verbal, mathematical and analytical skills.

The test does not measure a person's knowledge of specific fields of study. Of course, there are many other qualifications that will help you succeed in HHL's admission process – for instance job experience, leadership ability, motivation, and interpersonal skills. The HHL Part-time M.Sc. Entry Test does not measure these qualities. Instead it is used as standard criterion among other, more subjective criteria, such as essays and interviews.

The HHL Part-time M.Sc. Entry Test consists of three sections, and will altogether take 90 minutes:

Analytical writing (30 min)

The analytical writing section measures your ability to read and comprehend case studies. This includes case studies from different content areas you may not generally be familiar with.

Quantitative section (30 min)

The quantitative section measures your ability to reason quantitatively, solve quantitative problems and interpret data.

Verbal section (30 min)

The verbal section measures your ability to read and comprehend written material, to reason and evaluate arguments and to correct written material.
