## Part-time M.Sc. - Young Leader Scholarship

### Eligibility

Only applicants who apply for HHL's part-time M.Sc. Program for the September intake are eligible to apply for this scholarship.

### About the Scholarship

The HHL Young Leader Scholarship for part-time M.Sc. students targets successful future business leaders who want to study in HHL's part-time M.Sc. Program starting in September. Successful candidates will receive a tuition reduction of up to EUR 5,000 of the total tuition fee for the part-time M.Sc. Program. Social responsibility, effective leadership, and dedication describe the track record of the grantee that brings his/her leadership potential to HHL. In return, the grantee will support HHL's mission.

### Scholarship Selection Process

The selection committee evaluates the application and in case of a successful admission to the part-time M.Sc. program, you will be informed about the scholarship decision immediately.

### Requirements

Applicants must hold or be in the process of obtaining a first degree in business or equivalent (at least 180 ECTS credits) with an above average result. Furthermore, a very good result in the HHL Entry Test or a high GMAT score is required.

Only applicants who apply for HHL's part-time M.Sc. Program are eligible to apply for this scholarship.
