The HHL Dean's List scholarship aims to reward the most outstanding students of the HHL community each year. The top candidates admitted to our programs will be personally selected by the Chief Operating Officer, **Prof. Dr. Alexander Lahmann**, to join the exclusive Dean's List circle.

The fortunate members of the Dean's List receive a partial scholarship that covers half of the tuition fees for the chosen program. Along with the scholarship offer, recipients receive an official scholarship certificate. Additionally, recipients will be invited to the yearly Dean's dinner. This is a unique opportunity to network and exchange ideas about the world of tomorrow.

The following criteria can increase your chances of impressing our Dean:

- _ Distinguished academic performance
- _ Impressive professional progression
- _ Remarkable international experience
- _ Visible dedication to social causes or community development
- _ Outstanding admission interview with HHL professor
- _ GMAT score of at least 700 / HHL Entry Test of at least 17 points
- _ Demonstrated alignment with HHL values



The application deadline is June 30th of each year. Please hand in your scholarship application along with your program application to your responsible Manager Student Affairs at HHL. Your program application is the basis of a successful scholarship application.

The scholarship application must include a max. 90-second pitch video where you answer the following question: **As a Dean's List scholarship holder, what do you plan to give back to the HHL community during your studies and beyond?**

After the application deadline, the admission committees of each program will do a preselection of eligible candidates. Chosen candidates will receive an invitation to a virtual selection interview with Chief Operating Officer **Prof. Dr. Alexander Lahmann**. Once all interviews have taken place, the final decision will be communicated to the candidates by the respective Manager Student Affairs and the scholarship certificate as well as financial agreement will be sent out.
