

- Duration: 27 months (optional: term abroad) (on demand extendable up to 33 months)
- → **Program start:** Fall (1st residential week in September) | Early Bird Deadlines Nov. 30, Jan. 31 & Mar. 31 | Final Deadline Jun. 30 (Early Bird discounts: 3,500 | 2,500 | 1,500)
- Lecture format: 17 weekends (Friday − Sunday) at HHL |
   1 residential week per year, 1 week abroad (Global Immersion Seminar)






